The **County of Los Angeles Fire Department** is proud to present this training to the public.

Following a major disaster, police, fire and medical professionals may not be able to fully meet the demand. <u>People will have to rely on each other</u> to meet the immediate life saving and life sustaining needs, *particularly* in isolated neighborhoods that may be cut off from the main roads for a period of time.

The **County of Los Angeles Fire Department**'s **Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)** program was developed to provide basic training in safety and life saving skills for the general public.
