The Lomita Flight Strip Story

Thursday, Oct 16th, 6:30 reception - 7:00 presentation

Californians were panicked by the Pearl Harbor attack of Dec. 7, 1941, and civilian flights within 200 miles of the coast were immediately terminated.

Airfields were commandeered and new ones hastily built. One of these was the Lomita Flight Strip, known today as Zamperini Field or the Torrance Municipal Airport. Hear the remarkable story of how it came to be and the many fascinating people involved.

Charles Lobb is a Federal Aviation Administration-certified flight instructor and unofficial historian for Zamperini Field, the Torrance Airport. He is also author of Images of Aviation: Torrance Airport, published by Arcadia Publishing.
