NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following terms are expiring on City Commissions/Boards at the end of June, 2014:

Two (2) term expirations on the Planning Commission. The Commission works with the Planning Division for the orderly growth of the community including preparation of the comprehensive General Plan. It conducts investigations, holds hearings, and submits recommendations to the City Council on such matters as amendments to the Zoning Ordinance, tentative tract and parcel maps. The Commission consists of seven members and are appointed by City Council to serve four-year terms. The Commission meets at 6:30 PM on the second Monday of each month.

Two (2) term expirations on the Public Safety and Traffic Commission. The Commission consists of five members appointed by the City Council and advises on traffic and safety issues, such as police and fire protection, emergency preparedness, earthquake safety and other related items. The Commission protects the public health, safety and welfare of all Lomita residents, promotes public safety events, and sponsors programs in cooperation with the local schools, the Sheriff's Department and other agencies. The Commission meets at 6:00 PM on the fourth Wednesday of each month. Commissioners are appointed for four year terms.

One (1) term expiration on the Railroad Museum Foundation Board. The Board consists of five members appointed by City Council to serve four-year terms. The Board raises funds in support of the museum, plans and develops special events, makes budget recommendations, approves Foundation budget and recommends community programs. The Board meets at 6:00 PM on the second Monday of each month.

Interviews may be conducted by the City Council to fill the terms. Qualifications include Lomita residency and voter registration. Interested citizens should complete a citizen resume form and return to City Hall.
