



HOST FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES

- ☺ Provide the student with a place to sleep.
- ☺ Provide meals (such as breakfast, lunch, and dinner) when your student is with your family. While participating in planned activities, the Association will provide your student with money for meals.
- ☺ Provide transportation to and from "staging area" and/or activities.
- ☺ There will be at least one family weekend, if not two.
- ☺ All non-LSCA activities must have one (1) chaperone (at least 26 years old or older) in attendance.
- ☺ All drivers for LSCA activities must be at least 21 years old or older.
- ☺ If possible, host families are encouraged to participate in activities. Any costs (admission fees and meals) for the students and chaperon will be paid by the Association. Also, if there is an admission fee for a planned activity, the Association will pay for one member of each host family to attend (i.e. Disneyland, Knotts, & museums, etc.)
- ☺ Please be sure to contact the LSCA summer coordinator to make other arrangements if you are unable to transport your student, provide supervision, or have any questions, etc.
