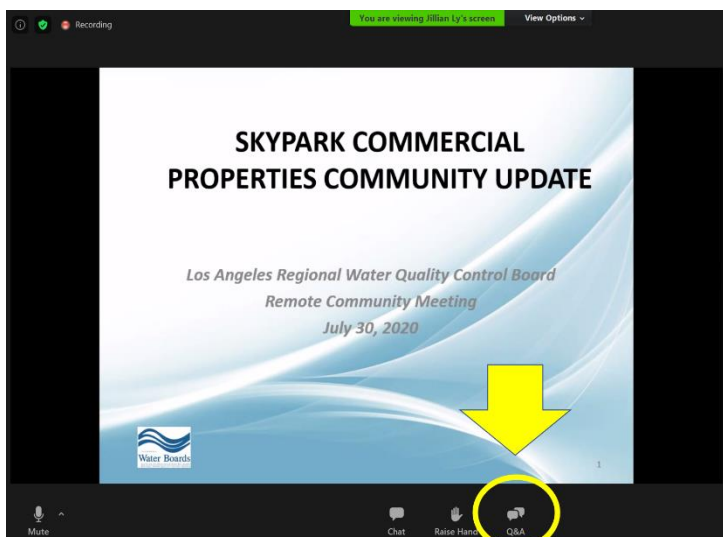

Background: As a result of the COVID-19 emergency and the Governor's Executive Orders N-29-20 and N-33-20, and to help protect public health, this meeting will occur via video/teleconference without a physical meeting location. The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) team asks for your patience and cooperation. While every effort has been made to streamline the participation process and conduct meetings in the manner to which our stakeholders have grown accustomed, there may be technical issues and human error. We will attempt to correct any issues immediately.

Participating via Zoom: You may join the meeting as early as 5:40 PM on the meeting day. Registration is not required to join the meeting. You do not need to install software on your computer to participate. The Zoom service can run within an existing web browser. Downloading the Zoom software may, however, provide a superior meeting experience for you. If you want to ask a question during the meeting: Questions can be submitted at any time during the meeting by typing them in the "Q&A" function at the bottom of the meeting window.



We will attempt to answer as many questions as possible in the time available; multiple questions on the same topic may be grouped together and answered simultaneously.

Participating via Telephone: The Zoom webinar allows individuals to dial in via phone; please see the phone number provided on the previous page. Please note that if you dial in by phone only you will not be able to see any presentation materials. You will not be able to submit questions during the meeting, so if you wish to submit a question prior to the meeting, please email jillian.ly@waterboards.ca.gov by **12 PM PST on July 29, 2020** and the question will be addressed in the same manner as those submitted during the meeting.

If you do not have access to a computer, you may ask questions via the free Zoom App on your smartphone. To join via the Zoom app, simply click "Join a Meeting" and enter the meeting ID **920 6462 6581** to be added to the meeting.

Guidelines for Orderly Participation
